Themes include animals, sea life, fantasy characters, vehicles, sports, nature, and food, so there is plenty of variety all year.

Two Levels of the Same Activity

Level 1: the drawing area holds a light gray starting shape. Students trace it and add the rest, so their drawing looks like the sample and they finish the page on their own.

Level 2: the drawing area is empty. Students build the whole drawing themselves, step by step.

Every worksheet is marked Level 1 or Level 2 in the top right corner, so printed pages are easy to sort.

You decide which level each student gets. Many teachers use Level 1 early in the year and Level 2 later, which makes growth easy to show.

How Each Activity Works

1. Follow the Steps: Students see how a drawing is built step by step using simple lines and shapes.
2. Trace: Students trace the completed drawing, reinforcing hand movements and building confidence before drawing independently.
3. Draw & Color: Students recreate the drawing on their own and then color it.
4. Trace & Write: Students trace and independently write the English word, reinforcing vocabulary and handwriting.

For Early Finishers

Small themed illustrations and lettering on each page can also be colored, giving early finishers more to do on their own.
